Activity 9.3

<u>Video – What Are My Values?</u>

Objectives:

 Explore how values affect decision making and promote values-based decisionmaking.

Materials:

 - o Explains how identifying your values helps you get the most of what you want
 - o Demonstrates how prioritizing values helps clarify your possible choices
 - o Describes how some values are situational and others are not

 - a. What have you learned?
 - b. How would you do this with your students?




The values above are a starter list. *Complete these steps.*

- 2. Circle the 8 values that have the highest priority to you.
- 3. Of the 8 circled, draw a star near the most important 4 values.
- 4. Of the 4 starred, draw a second star near the most important 2 values.
- 5. Write the final 2 values on the scale, then choose *the highest* priority value.
